## Georgia – Haiti Connection

### GOVERNMENT & COMMERCE

Georgia is served by the Haitian Consulate in Miami, FL.

### TRADE RELATIONSHIP

In 2009, Haiti ranked 75<sup>th</sup> among Georgia's export destinations with exports totaling more than \$28.5 million. Georgia ranked 6<sup>th</sup> among U.S. states in exports to Haiti. Georgia led among states in exports of cheese/curd, bread/pastry/pasta, and paint/varnish. Georgia ranked 2<sup>nd</sup> in exporting poultry, electric storage batteries, and worn clothing, and the state ranked 3<sup>rd</sup> in exporting electric sound/visual signaling apparatus, and primary cells & batteries.

In 2009 Haiti ranked 118<sup>th</sup> among countries from which Georgia imports goods; our state ranked 16<sup>th</sup> among U.S. states receiving imports from Haiti with imports totaling more than \$763.2 thousand. Top imports included: apparel/clothing, vegetables/fruit, straw, and essential oils.

### TRANSPORTATION

Delta offers daily flights to Port-au-Prince, Haiti via New York, NY.

American Airlines offers daily flights to Port-au-Prince, Haiti via Miami, FL.

### COMMUNITY & EDUCATION

As of 2006, 161 Haitians were enrolled in the University System of Georgia.
