GOVERNMENT & COMMERCE

TRADE RELATIONSHIP



In 2009, Honduras ranked 44th among Georgia's export destinations with exports totaling close to \$108.7 million. Georgia ranked 6th among U.S. states in exports to Honduras. Georgia led among states in exports of toilet paper/sanitary items, chemical/mineral fertilizers, and motor vehicle bodies. Georgia ranked 2nd in exporting cotton, paper/paperboard, and ink, and the state ranked 3rd in exporting nonwovens and parts/accessories for motor vehicles.

In 2009, Honduras ranked 37th among countries from which Georgia imports goods; our state ranked 6th among U.S. states receiving imports from Honduras with imports totaling more than \$177.9 million. Top imports included: apparel/clothing, vehicles (not railway), electrical machinery, and wood/articles of wood.
