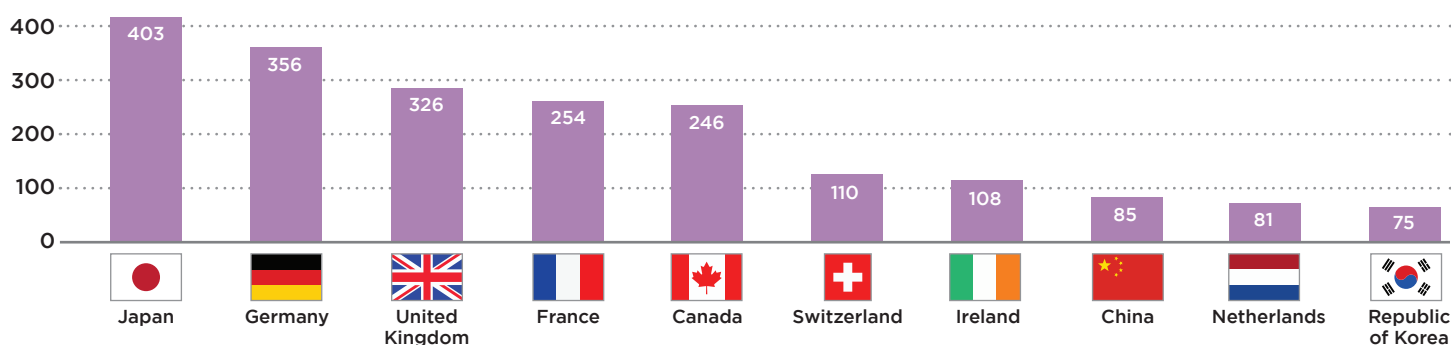

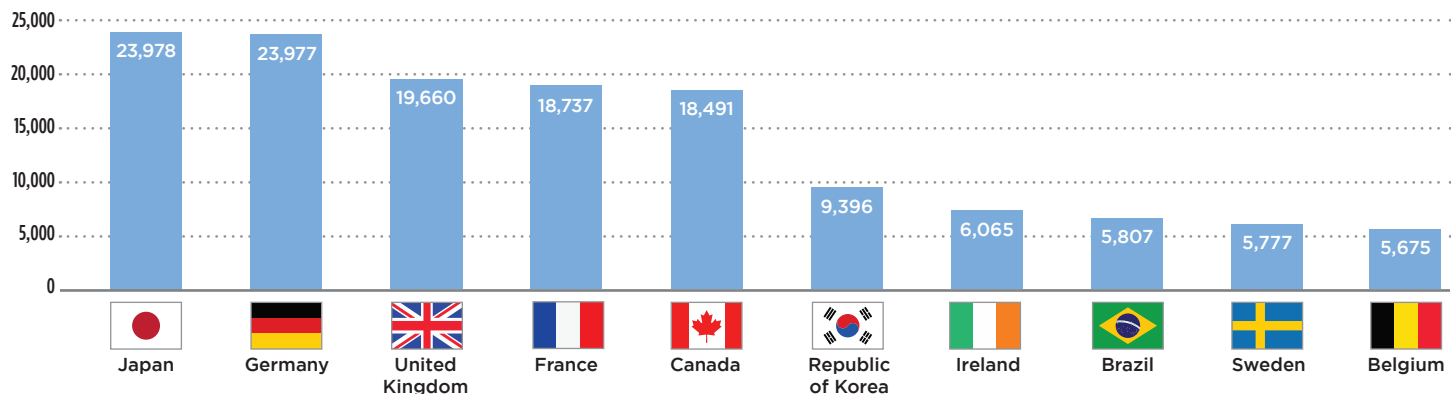

## TOP 10 COUNTRIES WITH FACILITIES IN GEORGIA



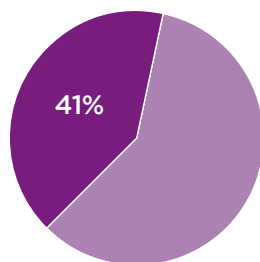
## TOP 10 COUNTRIES BY EMPLOYMENT IN GEORGIA

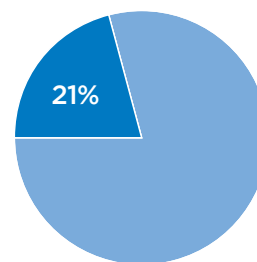

### 2018 INVESTMENT IN GEORGIA FROM INTERNATIONALLY-OWNED COMPANIES

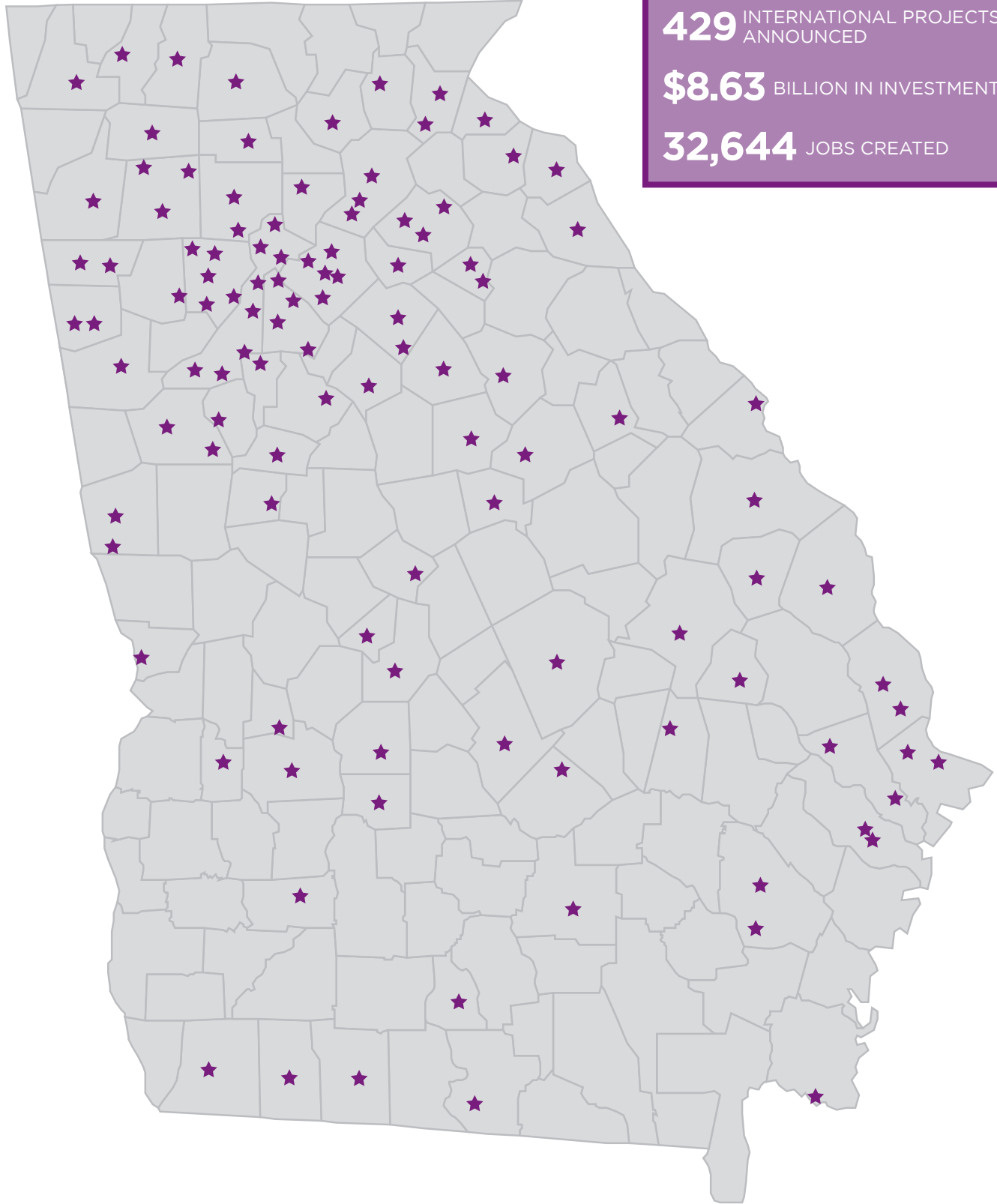
